The objective of London Wayfarers Hockey Club (LWHC) is to be respected for our hockey and known as a warm friendly club where our opposition, family and friends feel welcome.

The following Code of Conduct for Coaches, Club Officials and Volunteers has been written to uphold the aims of London Wayfarers Hockey Club and to ensure that all Club Officials and Volunteers adhere to the highest standards of ethical conduct and practice.

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is summarised below. All LWHC Club Officials and Volunteers must:

- Consider the well-being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play).
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Follow all guidelines laid down by the England Hockey and LWHC.
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover.
- Never exert undue influence over performers to obtain personal benefit or reward.

Never condone rule violations, rough play or the use of prohibitive substances.
